Monson has a long and meaningful history with the Anne Carlsen Center and the Jamestown community. He served on the Center's Board of Trustees for six years, most recently as Vice Chair. Monson previously oversaw the operations of the Center as a senior executive with Banner Health System, and its predecessor, Lutheran Health Systems, for 12 years—before ACC became an independently-owned organization. He has served as the Founder and Managing Partner of Novus, LLC, a Fargo-based consulting company providing strategic, marketing and operating services to health care and health-related organizations, for the past eight years.

Temporary Restriction
