There will be a grand opening in June to announce ACC's Community Services in the Fargo area.

The event is scheduled for 9 a.m. on June 10 at the Hjemkomst Center (202 First Avenue North) in Moorhead, Minn.

"We are growing in our capabilities to provide a range of community-based services," says ACC CEO Eric Monson. "We've learned a lot of the last couple of years, and we are applying those lessons in the Fargo area.
