The 28th Annual Benefit Golf Tournament for the Anne Carlsen Center (ACC) will be held Saturday, June 5, at Jamestown Country Club. The Mixed Scramble offers a fun day on the course, as well as awards and dinner. Tournament highlights include a \$40,000 hole-in-one contest and a \$25,000 putting contest.

ACC works to empower individuals of all abilities to experience life to its fullest. Those with the highest degrees of physical, cognitive and/or communicative impairments face limited camping opportunities. Funds raised from this year's tournament will help teenagers with disabilities make lasting memories and friendships at summer camp.

The Anne Carlsen Center Benefit Golf Tournament was the first of its kind in North Dakota when it began in 1982. ACC students take part in the volunteer effort at the tournament, posing for photos with the teams throughout the day and assisting with contests.

Registration for the June 5 tournament is at 8 a.m., with the shotgun start at 9 a.m. Play is limited to the first 132 paid entries. The fee is \$85 per person. The registration and payment deadline is May 29.
